

October 21, 2014

The Mooresville Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday, October 21, 2014, at 6:30 P. M. at the Mooresville Government Center.

Council members present: President Mark Mathis, Vice-President Virginia Perry, Tony Langley, George Watkins, and Jeff Cook. No members were absent. Town attorney Tim Currens was present.

Patrick Schmidt, Community Church of Mooresville, gave the prayer.

A motion was made by Councilman Watkins with a second by Councilwoman Perry to approve minutes of October 7, 2014 meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

Additional Appropriation Hearing: A motion was made by Councilman Watkins with a second by Councilman Langley to approve Resolution 12, 2014 to transfer \$19,000 from General miscellaneous to Police Department budget 101001324. Sale of Police Chief's car. Motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Perry with a second by Councilman Watkins to approve Resolution #13, 2014 to approve transfer of \$4,339.00 to MVH budget 201001443 from MVH miscellaneous. Auction sales. Motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Councilman Watkins with a second by Councilman Langley to approve Wastewater EDU's for TOA'S new construction in the amount of \$13,750.00. Motion carried 5-0.

Next, open bids for a 6inch main under White Lick Creek Bridge on Highway 67 South. MVH sent out 4 and received 2 back. Jason Price Excavating--\$46,965.00. JDH Construction--\$62,448.20. Dave Moore, Street Superintendent, will review the bids.

Other business: Councilman Langley reported the Town had a year to move forward to purchase the water company for 23 million dollars. The lawsuit has been dropped and Indiana American has now said the Town would be in the lower tier until investments are made to the Town. A motion was made by Councilman Langley with a second by Councilwoman Perry to not acquire the water company. Motion carried 5-0.

Legal: A motion was made by Councilman Watkins with a second by Councilman Langley to approve Resolution 14, 2014, fees for document copies. Motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Councilman Langley with a second by Councilman Watkins to approve payment of the claims in the amount of \$258,180.72. Motion carried 5-0.

Dave Moore told the council he wanted to table awarding the bid. A motion was made by Councilman Watkins with a second by Councilwoman Perry to table this item. Motion carried 5-0.

Councilwoman Perry asked about the Council President having meetings with the county on the dispatch equipment. Council President Mathis said he was meeting to gather information and that he himself couldn't make any decisions because this would be a council decision.


Councilwoman Perry reported to the council she had sent a draft of a policy on the use of the Government Center to the members. She would like this to be on agenda for next meeting. No fees involved.

Councilwoman Perry had asked the council to wear pink and there were pink agendas for the meeting.

There being no further business to come before the council a motion was made by Councilman Cook with a second by Councilman Watkins to adjourn the meeting.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 at 6:30 P. M. at the Mooresville Government Center.

Mark Mathis, Council President, told the public that Public Comments will be added to the agenda.
